The Accreditation Scheme for Laboratories ensures the technical competence of laboratories to perform specific types of testing, calibration and measurement. It provides formal recognition that laboratories are competent, impartial and independent. SAC re-evaluates laboratories regularly to ensure their continued compliance with requirements and maintenance of their operations.

Who can be accredited?

Accreditation is open to all laboratories, ranging from in-house to independent third party laboratories. The accreditation scopes include:

What are the criteria?

Laboratories are accredited based on:

- ISO/IEC 17025 General requirements for the competence of testing and calibration laboratories
- ISO 15189 Medical Laboratories Requirements for quality and competence (this applies to medical testing laboratories and medical imaging facilities)
